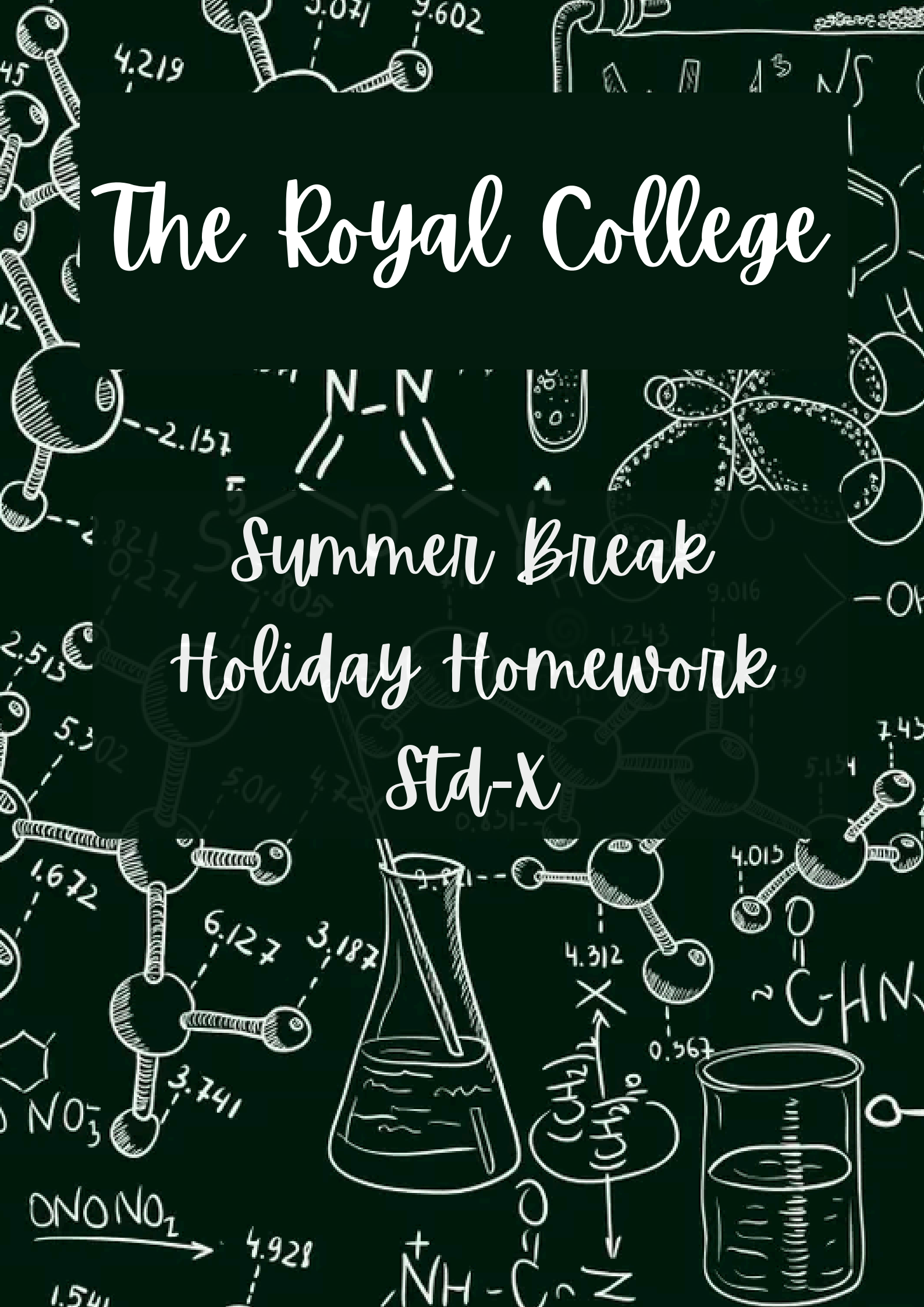

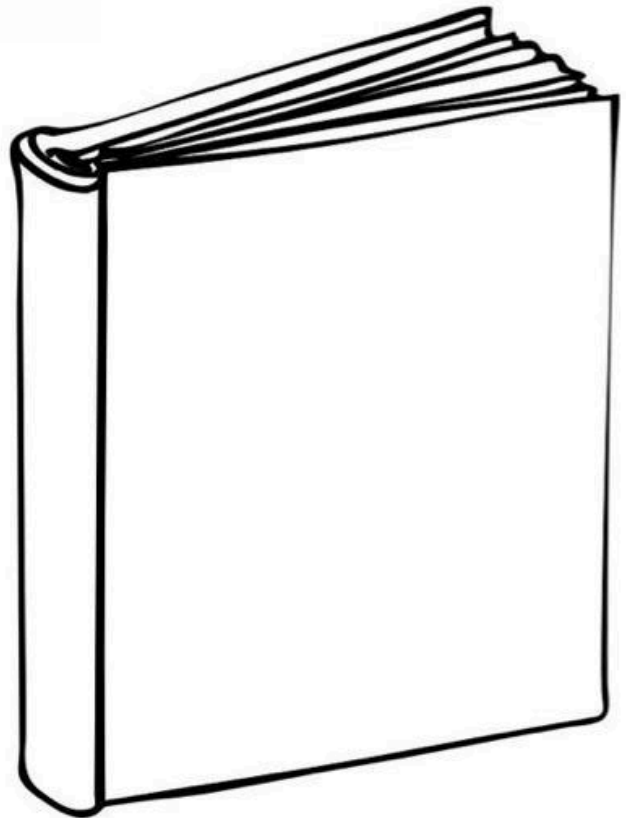

This course is extremely important for your future studies and will be beneficial for admissions to higher institutions.

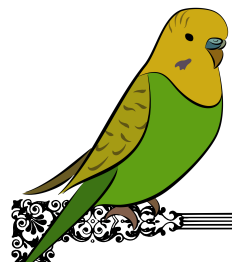
